

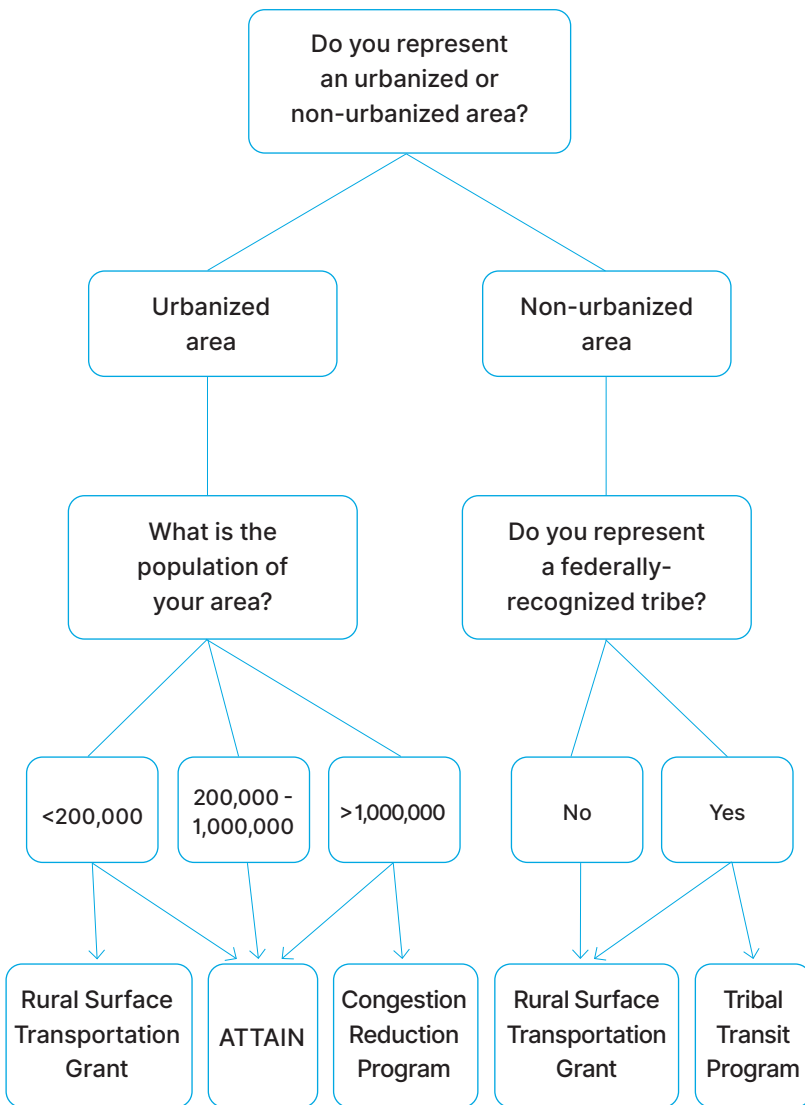


Funding microtransit in your city.
