


Funding microtransit in your city.

Federal competitive grants include:


- 1. ICAM
- 2. ATTAIN
- 3. Rural Surface Transportation Grant
- 4. Tribal Transit
- 5. Congestion Relief



Does your state have a CMAQ or Carbon Reduction program you can get microtransit funding from? Does your state have another innovative transit grant program?

For instance:

- Massachusetts has a Community Connections Grant and Regional Transit Innovation Grant
- California has TIRCP and Clean Mobility Options (CMO)
- Florida has an Innovative Service Delivery Grant
