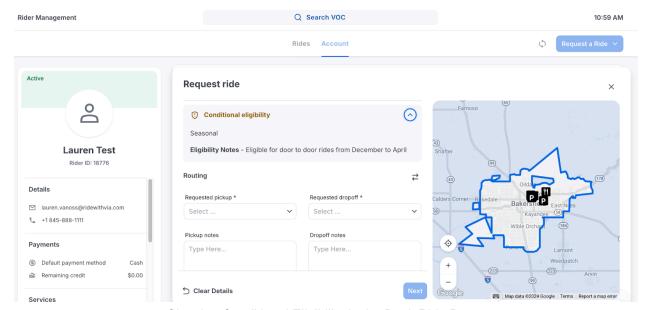
# Get to know the new Conditional Eligibility updates

## What's New?

You will see if a rider is eligible for a specific service and under what conditions. You can find this information on the Rider Management Page for each rider, by going to the "Account" tab and looking at the "Eligibility" section, and this information is also visible while booking a ride in the VOC for the rider. In this way, you will not have to toggle between different pages in the VOC but have all the information you need on the Book Ride Page.

Additionally, a report in the VOC Analytics menu item will become available specifically showing information about Rider Eligibility and will include the Rider ID, eligibility start and end date + Eligibility Status. When relevant, this will also include the Eligibility Type, Conditions & Notes.

## **How it Works**

When creating or editing a Rider Account, you will be able to toggle on or off the specific services the rider will be eligible for (for instance, "microtransit" and "paratransit") and insert the Eligibility Dates. For each service, you will now also be able to add specific conditions to the service' eligibility for the rider.

This means you will have 4 different input fields regarding eligibility for each rider per service

- 1. Eligibility dates
- Eligibility type Conditional, Unconditional, Not Eligible or any Custom options

- 3. Eligibility conditions Multi-select field
- 4. Eligibility condition notes Free text field

We will describe these 4 fields in detail and give examples on how you can use this to ensure your staff always has the right information to decide if they should book a ride for a rider.

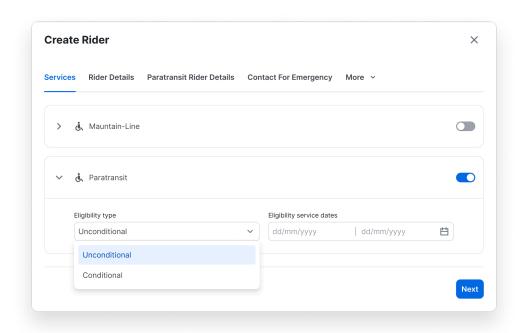
### 1. Eligibility dates

Below each service you can add dates for when the rider is eligible. During these dates, an Agent or Dispatcher can book rides for the rider for that service - or the rider can book rides for themselves in the Rider App. When the dates have expired, it is no longer possible to book rides for this particular service

- Note that VOC users & Riders can only book rides within the Eligibility dates, but they
  can also only book rides for days that are within the Eligibility dates
- An example: Rider John has Paratransit eligibility from 10/01/2024 until 11/01/2024. On 09/30/2024 the rider, nor a VOC user, can book a ride for John that is scheduled for 10/01/2024

### 2. Eligibility type - Conditional or Unconditional

- When selecting Unconditional, the rider will always be eligible for this specific service (unless an Agent changes this).
- When selecting Conditional, the Via system will display more information about the conditionality through the "Eligibility conditions" and "Eligibility conditions notes" fields.



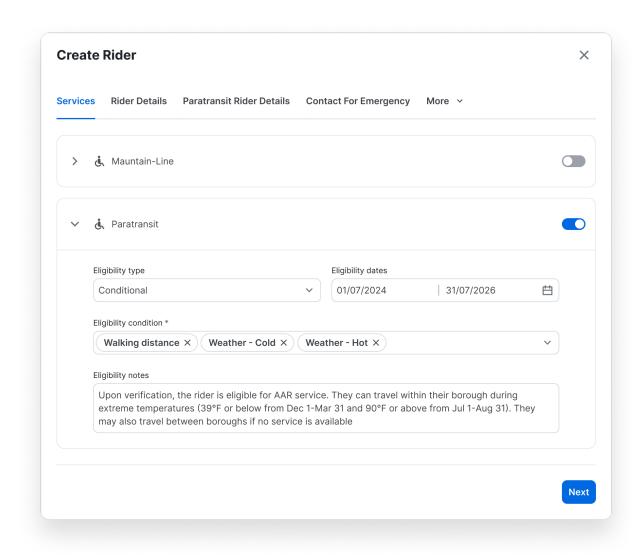
Setting the Eligibility type & Eligibility dates for a rider, in this example for the "Paratransit" service

# 3. Eligibility conditions - Multi-select

Several types of Eligibility conditions can be selected to show Agents and Dispatchers in the VOC exactly when or why a rider is (in)eligible for a service. An example could be "Day Center" for the "Paratransit" service; the rider will be eligible for Paratransit rides when requesting a ride to or from the Day Center. You can choose Eligibility conditions from a drop down menu that includes default options. If you want to add additional custom options, please let the Via team know by submitting a Zendesk ticket.

### 4. Eligibility condition notes - Free text field

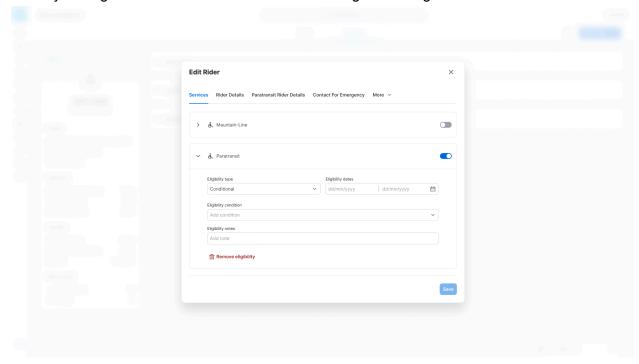
Do you need to add any other context for a rider's (conditional) eligibility that your Agents and Dispatchers should be aware of? You can add this in the free text field called Eligibility condition notes



Setting the Eligibility Condition and added additional Eligibility notes on the "Paratransit" service of the Rider Account. Note that the "Eligibility condition" field is only shown when the Eligibility type is set as "Conditional"

Please note that Eligibility Conditions are not enforced by the Via system automatically. If an Agent or Dispatcher decides to book a ride for the Rider that goes against the information displayed in the Conditional Eligibility, the Via system will not block users from doing this.

Do you want to edit or delete specific Eligibility information at a Riders account? This can be done by editing the Rider account on the Rider Management Page
